THIS MATTER coming before the undersigned Judge presiding over the August 26, 2013 civil session of Wake County Superior Court upon motion by plaintiff State of North Carolina for a Temporary Restraining Order under N.C. Gen. Statute § 75-14 prohibiting defendants from sending invoices to or collecting or attempting to collect money from companies or firms that are either situated in North Carolina or registered to do business in North Carolina with the North Carolina Secretary of State; and Assistant Attorney General Creecy Johnson and Special Deputy Attorney General David N. Kirkman of the North Carolina Department of Justice appearing on behalf of plaintiff; and plaintiff's counsel having advised the Court that they were contacted by defendants' Michigan counsel after defendants were given notice of this hearing yesterday and that defendant's Michigan counsel agreed that they would not oppose the entry of

the following Order and would, instead, stipulate to its entry, provided that none of their possible defenses in this case would be deemed to be waived and that they would be entitled to contest plaintiff's application for a Preliminary Injunction; and it appearing to the Court from counsel's representations, together with the record in this cause, that the following Order should be entered pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 75-14;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that defendants, their employees, corporate officers, agents, representatives, private mailbox services, commercial mail receiving agencies, successors and assigns, together with any other party acting in concert with any defendant having knowledge hereof, be and hereby are Restrained and Prohibited during the next ten days from:

- 1) Billing or invoicing any business that is located in North Carolina or registered to do business in the state;
- 2) Cashing, negotiating, depositing, forwarding, or otherwise processing for payment any check, bank draft or credit card account information obtained from any business that is located in North Carolina or registered to do business in the state;
- 3) Sending notices, letters, invoices, solicitation materials, collection letters or similar communications to any business that is located in North Carolina or registered to do business in the state;
- 4) Opening, forwarding or transferring any item of mail that was sent to defendants or their agents in care of 3434 Edwards Mill Road, box, Postal Mail Box or suite number 112 #325, Raleigh, NC 27612-4276; and
- 5) Doing anything with the items or information mentioned in the four preceding subparagraphs, other than hold and maintain them in their own possession and in the items' current locations, pending further orders from this Court.
