# NCAC Code Revision Proposals

#### Minimum Standards, 12 NCAC 09B .0101

- ▶ Add (3)(i) "not engage in excessive or unjustified use of force or abuse of power of the position." (TREC Rec 40, 41)
  - ▶ Commissions would need to define both use of force and abuse of power
  - ▶ Would therefore allow for suspension/revocation/denial for same
- Amend (6) to repeat psych evals either after a certain number of years or before promotion (TREC Rec 45)
  - ▶ TREC Rec 44 has already explicitly supported the CJ Commission's action with respect to psych evals
  - ▶ **TREC Rec 60** suggests revisions to minimum standards after study of relationship between mental/physical health and job performance
  - See NCSA Rec #2 & 3 for Minimum Standards, similar recommendation about study
- Add (8)(f) to require notification by both officer and agency of specific use of force incidents (TREC Rec 42)
  - ▶ Commissions would need to define use of force
  - Pending legislation may mandate this anyway

#### Other Code Provisions:

- Data Collection (TREC Rec 53)
  - Commissions to collect demographic data for those entering BLET, graduating BLET, and certified by each Commission
  - DOJ already working on this, may be part of legislation

- Consistency in Code Provisions Between Commissions (TREC Rec 54)
  - Minimum standards and revocation/suspension/denial should be same for all LEOs in state
  - Also recommended by NCSA

#### Other Code Provisions, cont.:

- Additions to MIST (TREC Rec 57) (See also TREC Rec 2 Add CIT; Rec 29 Protest Training)
  - ▶ May be mooted by pending legislation then becomes a Commission policy issue
  - NCSA & NCACP have similar recommendations

- Revamp BLET (TREC Rec 56)
  - ► Commission is already involved , may require changes to 12 NCAC 09B .0205
  - NCSA and NCACP have similar recommendations

# Policy Proposals

- Increase transparency about officer discipline and decertification (TREC Rec 43)
  - ▶ DOJ is already working on this
  - May require legislative changes
  - NCACP and NCSA have similar recommendations
- ► Strengthen NCLEA (TREC Rec 46)
  - Commission is already involved
  - NCSA and NCACP have similar recommendations
- Expand and fund CJ Fellows (TREC Rec 52)
  - Commission is already involved
  - NCSA and NCACP have similar recommendations

### Best Practices Recommendations

- ► Facilitation of Peaceful Demonstrations (TREC Rec 27 & 28)
  - Commissions could mandate training
  - Commissions could lead/participate in formation of Best Practices Advisory Group

- Require Creation of Diversity Task Force at each LEA (TREC Rec 55)
  - Commissions could lead/participate in formation of Best Practices Advisory Group
  - NCACP has similar recommendation

- Develop Best Practices Guide for Recruitment and Retention (TREC Rec 51)
  - Commissions could lead/participate in formation of Best Practices Advisory Group
  - NCSA has similar recommendation

# Proposal for Committee Action
