Statutory Authority for Proposed Rules Changes: NCGS 17E: On September 13, 2019, the North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission proposed an amendment to 12NCAC 10B .0407 to further clarify the process for a former elected or appointed Sheriff to obtain justice officer certification upon leaving office. Fiscal Impact: None

Procedure for Subjecting a Proposed Rule to Legislative Review:

The Commission will receive written objections until 5:00 p.m. on the day following the day the Commission approves the rule. 7	(a) The Division	n shall issue a General Certification to any person as either a deputy sheriff, a detention officer, or
8	telecommunicator who has previously served as an elected or appointed sheriff, if the person:	
9	(1)	applies to the Commission within one year of ceasing to serve as an elected or appointed sheriff;

11	(2)	has served as an elected or appointed sheriff for a minimum of eight years; and
12	(3)	left the office of sheriff in good standing.
13	(b) The Divisio	n shall issue a General Certification to any person as either a deputy sheriff, a detention officer, or
14	telecommunicator who has previously served as an elected or appointed sheriff, if the person:	
15	(1)	applies to the Commission within one year of ceasing to serve as an elected or appointed sheriff;

17	(2)	has served as an elected or appointed sheriff for a minimum of four years and has held a General
18	Certification as deputy sheriff, detention officer, or telecommunicator with the North Carolina Sheriffs'

27	(3)	submitted to the Division verification that the applicant meets the requirement of this Rule
