I. CALL TO ORDER

The North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission's Final Agency Decision meeting was called to order by Sheriff Alan Cloninger on Thursday, June 16, 2022.

Chair Cloninger recognized Richard Squires as the new Sheriffs' Training and Standards Director. Chair Cloninger recognized host Sheriff John Ingram; Sheriff Ingram welcomed everyone to Brunswick County. Chair Cloninger requested a roll call of Commission members. Chair Cloninger announced that a quorum was present.

Commission Chair Cloninger noted that Mr. Chris Brooks, Assistant Attorney General, would serve as the Commission Legal Counsel. Mr. Brooks read the ethics statement to the Commission members and reminded everyone that both the Petitioner and the Respondent would be limited to 30 minutes of oral argument.

Chair Cloninger welcomed everyone to the meeting. Sheriff Cloninger then asked visitors to stand and introduce themselves.

II. FINAL AGENCY DECISION

Bob Pickett

*Marcus Lamonte Hands

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the Sheriffs' Commission Members and stated that Mr. Marcus Hands holds Detention Officer Certification through the New Hanover County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Bob Pickett presented oral arguments regarding the case against Mr. Marcus Hands. He presented that the Petitioner lacks good moral character necessary for his justice officer certification.

He stated an Administrative hearing was held on January 5, 2022, before administrative Law Judge, Stacey Bice Bawtinhimer, regarding whether Petitioner displayed a lack of good moral character when he obtained a banned study guide from another student, was involved in distributing it, and then lied to the instructor about possessing it. The Administrative Law Judges proposal for decision based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the

Petitioner's justice officer certification be retained and no action be taken against Petitioner's justice officer certification.

Chair Cloninger asked the Commission if there were any questions. Negative response. The Petitioners attorney, Jennifer J. Knox presented oral arguments regarding the case.

Attorney Jennifer J. Knox does not dispute anything that Mr. Bob Pickett presented to the commission and agrees with the Administrative Law Judges proposed decision that no action be taken against Mr. Hand's justice Officer Certification.

Mr. Hand's was recognized and addressed the commission. He stated that he regret what he did and that he would never do anything like this ever again.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Alan Norman to enter a closed session; seconded by Sheriff Mike Roberson. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A MOTION was made by Sheriff Mike Roberson to enter open session; seconded by Sheriff Landric Reid. MOTION CARRIED.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson in the matter of Mr. Marcus Lamonte Hands; we find at the occurrence of this event that Mr. Hands lacked good moral character, but since then Mr. Hands has rehabilitated himself and at this time we find that Mr. Hands has good moral character and take no further action; seconded by Sheriff Doug Doughtie. **MOTION CARRIED**. **[Attachment #1]**

III. FINAL AGENCY DECISION

Bob Pickett

*Tawanda T. Tillery

Chair Cloninger stated that Ms. Tillery was not present. Chairman Cloninger asked Mr. Pickett to present the evidence.

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the Sheriffs' Commission Members and stated that Ms. Tawanda T. Tillery is an applicant for Justice Officer Certification with the Nash County Sheriff's Office.

He stated an administrative hearing was held on March 24, 2022, before Administrative Law Judge Michael C. Byrne, regarding whether Petitioner's justice officer certification should be denied for making a material misrepresentation by failing to list a 2001 Simple Assault charge on her Sheriffs' Standards Personal History Statement or for failing to timely notify the Division of a new misdemeanor charge (Harassing Phone Call 20 CR 051441) after the date of appointment. The Administrative Law Judges proposal for decision based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby ordered that Petitioner's justice officer certification, not be denied, but rather that in lieu of denial, Petitioner's certification be placed in a probationary period of five years on the condition that during that period or probation, Petitioner not violate any laws other than infractions of this state or any other state, any federal laws, or any rules of this Commission or the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission.

Chair Cloninger asked the Commission if there were any questions. Negative response.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson to enter a closed session; seconded by Mr. Marc Nichols. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Mike Roberson to enter open session; seconded by Sheriff Shelton White. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson in the matter of Tawanda T. Tillery; that we adopt counsel's recommendation, that her certification not be denied but she be placed on probation for five years; seconded by Sheriff Landric Reid. **MOTION CARRIED.** [Attachment #2]

IV. FINAL AGENCY DECISION

*Nathan Alexander Caudill

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the Sheriffs' Commission Members and stated that Mr. Nathan Caudill is an applicant for justice officer certification with the Randolph County Sheriff's Office. He stated an administrative hearing was held on September 29, 2021, before administrative Law Judge Jonathan S. Dills, regarding whether Petitioner's justice officer certification should be denied on the grounds that Petitioner committed a Class B misdemeanor offense of Assault on a Female or that he lacked of good moral character. The Administrative Law Judges proposal for decision based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is proposed that Petitioner's justice officer certification be granted.

Chair Cloninger asked the Commission if there were any questions. Negative response.

A **MOTION** was made by Mr. Marc Nichols to enter a closed session; seconded by Sheriff Mike Roberson. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Shelton White to enter open session; seconded by Sheriff Jack Smith. **MOTION CARRIED.**

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Landric Reid in the matter of Nathan Caudill; that we accept counsel's recommendation to grant his certification, also in the proposed Final Agency Decision we keep line 15 that reads "Kubala was not credible" and strike the remaining information; seconded by Mr. Marc Nichols. **MOTION CARRIED**. V. FINAL AGENCY DECISION

Bob Pickett

*Michael Anthony Lee Jr.

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the members of the Sheriffs' Commission stating that Michael A. Lee Jr. is an applicant for justice officer certification with the Rutherford County Sheriff's Office. He stated an administrative hearing was held on October 6, 2021, before Administrative Law Judge David F. Sutton, regarding whether Petitioner's justice office certification should be denied on the ground Petitioner lacked good moral character, had made a material misrepresentation by omitting information that he has previously purchased and sold methamphetamine, or committed the Felony offense of Possession with Intent to Sell, Manufacture or Deliver. The Administrative Law Judges proposal for decision based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is proposed that Petitioner's justice officer certification be revoked for a period of five years for making a material misrepresentation. Further, it is ordered that Petitioner's justice officer certification be revoked indefinitely for failure to maintain good moral character.

Chair Cloninger asked the Commission if there were any questions. Negative response. Chair Cloninger asked that our records reflect that Mr. Lee received a proper notice for the Final Agency Decision meeting but did not show up. A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson to enter a closed session; seconded by Sheriff Alan Norman. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Mike Roberson to enter open session; seconded by Sheriff Doug Doughtie. **MOTION CARRIED.**

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson in the matter of Michael A. Lee Jr; that we adopt counsel's recommendation to revoke justice officer certification for five years for making a material misrepresentation and further it be ordered that the petitioners justice officer certification be revoked indefinitely; seconded by Sheriff Mike Roberson. **MOTION CARRIED**.
