I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Cloninger announced that a quorum was present.

Chair Cloninger noted that Mr. Chris Brooks, Assistant Attorney General, would serve as the Commission Legal Counsel. Mr. Brooks read the ethics statement to the Commission members and reminded everyone that both the Petitioner and the Respondent would be limited to 30 minutes of oral argument.

Chair Cloninger welcomed everyone to the meeting. Sheriff Cloninger then asked visitors to stand and introduce themselves.

Chairman Cloninger asked Alex Radford to administer the oaths for Sheriff Jeff Crisco who was newly appointed to the commission and Sheriff Terry Johnson who was re-appointed to his seat on the Commission.

*Caleb Dean Costner

Chair Cloninger recused himself for the matter of Caleb Dean Costner. Vice Chair Jack Smith presided over the matter of Caleb Dean Costner.

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the Sheriffs' Commission Members and stated that Mr. Caleb Dean Costner is seeking certification as a Deputy Sheriff with the Gaston County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Bob Pickett presented oral arguments regarding the case against Mr. Caleb Dean Costner. He presented that the petitioner lacks good moral character.

Vice Chair Smith asked the Commission if there were any questions. Sheriff's Terry Johnson, Jeff Crisco, Doug Doughtie, Mike Roberson, Shelton White and Mr. Marc Nichols questioned Mr. Costner. The petitioner's attorney, William Augustus presented oral arguments regarding the case.

Attorney Augustus does not dispute anything that Mr. Bob Pickett presented to the commission but disagrees with the Administrative Law Judge's proposed decision to deny Mr. Costner's justice Officer Certification.

Mr. Costner was recognized and addressed the Commission. He stated that he regrets what he did and admits wrongdoing but believes that he has shown good moral character over the past four years working within the Gaston County Sheriff's Office.

Vice Chair Smith asked questions of Captain Monica L. Becton, Chief Deputy Gary A. Williams, and Sheriff Alan Cloninger, who were present to speak regarding Mr. Costner's character. They all spoke highly of Mr. Costner and said that he has grown from those incidents.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson to enter closed session; seconded by Sheriff Mike Roberson. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Shelton White to enter open session; seconded by Mr. Marc Nichols. **MOTION CARRIED.**

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Terry Johnson in the matter of Mr. Caleb Dean Costner; we adopt counsel's proposed decision that Mr. Costner's justice officer certification be denied indefinitely; seconded by Sheriff Doug Doughtie. **MOTION CARRIED**. [Attachment #1]

III. FINAL AGENCY DECISION

Bob Pickett

*Joshua Ryan Core

Retired Sheriff David Smith recused himself for the matter of Joshua Ryan Core.

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the Sheriffs' Commission members and stated that Mr. Joshua Ryan Core is an applicant for justice officer certification with the Granville County Sheriff's Office. In his oral argument he stated that this case has been continued from the September 2022 Commission Meeting. The Administrative Law Judge's proposal for decision based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, recommends that the Commission deny the petitioner's justice officer certification for five years.

Mr. Core was not present for the Final Agency Decision.

Chair Cloninger asked the Commission if there were any questions. Negative response.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Mike Roberson to enter a closed session; seconded by Sheriff Terry Johnson. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Mr. Marc Nichols to enter open session; seconded by Sheriff Jack Smith. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Mike Roberson in the matter of Joshua Ryan Core; that we adopt counsel's recommendation, that his certification be denied for five years; seconded by Sheriff Shelton White. **MOTION CARRIED**. [Attachment #2]

*Jackie Yvonne Davis

Mr. Bob Pickett addressed the Sheriffs' Commission members and stated that Ms. Jackie Yvonne Davis holds justice officer certification with the Vance County Sheriff's Office. In his oral argument he stated Ms. Davis was convicted of Misdemeanor Larceny, a Class B misdemeanor in 2013. While petitioner did commit the violation for which respondent found probable cause, due to mitigating circumstances, including the age of the violations at issue, petitioner's admission of them by stipulation and testimony, and petitioner's otherwise creditable professional history lack of criminal activity or rule violations, a probationary sanction is an appropriate resolution. The Administrative Law Judge's proposal for decision based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, recommends that the petitioner's justice officer certification be placed on probationary status for one year.

Ms. Davis was not present for the Final Agency Decision.

Chair Cloninger asked the Commission if there were any questions. Negative response.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Mike Roberson to enter a closed session; seconded by Mr. Marc Nichols. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Mr. Marc Nichols to enter open session; seconded by Sheriff Shelton White. **MOTION CARRIED**.

A **MOTION** was made by Sheriff Doug Doughtie in the matter of Jackie Yvonne Davis; that we accept counsel's recommendation, and not deny her certification but place her on probation for one year; seconded by Sheriff Terry Johnson.
