BASIC MILITARY POLICE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING

The basic training course for military police officers consists of instruction designed to provide the trainee with the skills and knowledge to perform those tasks essential to function in law enforcement. The course entitled "Basic Military Police Law Enforcement Training" shall consist of a minimum of 498 hours of instruction and shall include the following identified topical areas and minimum instructional hours for each:
