## **Reason for rule change:**

The Sheriff's Commission voted to not require sheriff deputies to complete Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) prior to taking their oath of office. The Commission voted to return to the previous requirement that BLET be completed during their probationary period.

#### **Procedure for Subjecting a Proposed Rule to Legislative Review:**

If an objection is not resolved prior to the adoption of the rule, a person may also submit written objections to the Rules Review Commission. If the Rules Review Commission receives written and signed objections in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.3(b2) from 10 or more persons clearly requesting review by the legislature and the Rules Review Commission approves the rule, the rule will become effective as provided in G.S. 150B-21.3(b1). The Commission will receive written objections until 5:00 p.m. on the day following the day the Commission approves the rule. The Commission will receive those objections by mail, delivery service, hand delivery, or facsimile transmission. Rules .0503(a), 0602(a), and .1303(a) of this Subchapter. 7 For certification as a deputy sheriff the probationary period begins on the date the officer took the Oath of Office after 8 completion of Basic Law Enforcement Training as described in 12 NCAC 10B .0502 and 12 NCAC 09B .0205.
