- Officers may submit information attesting that training is applicable to their current duties and responsibilities. For example, detention officers would not normally receive credit for law enforcement drivers training, however, a detention officer who regularly drives the prisoner transport would need this type of training to perform their duties and therefore would receive credit.
- In addition, there are types of training which are county-specific, such as boating safety courses and scuba diving, and will be evaluated on an individual basis.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE APPLICABLE TO PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATES

TRAINING THAT CANNOT BE CREDITED TOWARDS PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATES

- Education or training points will not be awarded for correspondence courses, on-line or vocational courses unless courses are credited toward a degree by an accredited institution.
- Education or training points will not be awarded for courses such as painting, cabinet making, woodworking, etc.
