What is the More Powerful NC campaign?

The More Powerful NC campaign is an awareness and communications campaign created by Attorney General Josh Stein and Department of Health and Human Services Secretary Mandy Cohen to help fight the opioid epidemic in North Carolina. The campaign is working to raise awareness about the devastating effects of the opioid crisis, which causes five deaths in our state every day, on average.

More Powerful NC is anchored in the message that together, we are more powerful than opioids. We all can and should play a part in taking back our communities from the grips of this epidemic.

The campaign website (MorePowerfulNC.org) provides information about how North Carolinians can get help, get involved, and get the facts about the crisis. It gives people actionable steps to safely store and dispose of medications, talk to their doctors and families about the risks associated with opioids, and get involved with prevention and recovery efforts in their schools, companies, and communities.

Who is behind this campaign?
