3 **12 NCAC 09C .0104 DEPARTMENT HEAD RESPONSIBILITIES: CRITICAL INCIDENT**

6 (a) For all law enforcement agencies in the State that employ personnel certified by the North Criminal Justice  
7 Education and Training Standards Commission, the Department head shall submit the Annual Critical Incident Report,  
8 (F-27), to the Criminal Justice Standards Division no later than the following January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year listing all  
9 incidents involving any use of force by a law enforcement officer or justice officer that results in death or serious  
10 bodily injury to a person. The Annual Critical Incident Report (F-27) shall contain the following:

11 (1) date of incident

12 (2) location of incident

13 (3) person(s) involved and their participation

14 (4) whether the incident involved serious bodily injury or death

15 (b) Information contained in the submitted Annual Critical Incident Report, (F-27) , that is confidential under State  
16 or federal law shall remain confidential.
