Required Fields *

The application, transcripts, references, copy of your driver's license, AOC records checks from all counties you have resided in or may have been charged in (if at or over 18), and SAT and/or ACT scores must be received in our office by **May 31st at 5:00pm**. We will accept the application and accompanying documents by email, mail, or fax. Any documents received after that time will not be processed. If you are sending the documents by mail then please allow time for them to be received by our office. We do not go by the post marked date.
