Firearms and Calibers that are Currently Being Entered into IBIS:

- **Firearms that are regularly test fired for entry into IBIS/NIBIN include** all <u>semiautomatic</u> pistols, rifles, and shotguns. These types of firearms auto-eject fired cartridge cases after firing, which may be recovered as evidence after firearm incidents.
- Firearms that are not typically test fired for entry into IBIS/NIBIN include non-semiautomatic firearms such as revolvers, derringers, single shot or bolt-action rifles, and some non-semiautomatic shotguns. These types of firearms do not automatically eject fired cartridge cases after firing, reducing the likelihood of recovery as evidence after firearms incidents.

Test fire Recommendations to Achieve High Quality IBIS Input:
