Technology Initiative

Reentry Tablets through APDS (American Prison Data Systems) who provide education, rehabilitation, and reentry services to incarcerated individuals.

Designated Reentry facilities for R-STEP participants who are 9 months from Projected Release Date.

Facilitate offenders, service providers, and correctional staff to safely share information that encourages and sustains self-sufficiency and accountability.

Reentry applications and service provider referral platform can be accessible through correctional tablets to improve reentry planning and preparation prior to release from incarceration and enhances connection to community resources post-release

A personal experience created for each participant. A common goal to boost learning, inspire behavior change and reduce prison violence.

17 Local Reentry Councils have designated staff trained on POKKET.
