Here is a list of possible topics and projects that the Judicial Committee can reflect on, and possibly present on, at the October 7th meeting:

- Fines and Fees – Statutory changes to repeal monetary penalties and give judges increased judicial discretion
- School Justice Partnerships
- Pretrial Policies and Bail
- Ability to Pay – Bolster 415 form use and training
- Reentry / Collateral Consequences of Conviction – Host reentry simulations for legislators
- Prosecutor Discretion – Plea bargaining, advanced supervised release, habitual felony working groups
- Public Defenders – Expand IDS offices statewide
- Expunction – Expand awareness of and access to license restoration clinics and NC pro bono resource center services
- Representative Juries – study the extent to which jury lists created at the state level reflect the adult population of each county based on a variety of demographic factors.
