



Impact of the Withholding of Federal Education Funding on North Carolina's Public Schools

On June 30, 2025, the U.S. Department of Education (USED) notified all states that, due to the change in administration, it is reviewing federal Fiscal Year 2025 (school year 2025-26) funding decisions of approximately \$165.6 million in grant programs that North Carolina typically receives. These programs include:

- Title I, Part C (Education of Migratory Children) - \$5.4 million¹
- Title II, Part A (Supporting Effective Instruction) - \$67.9 million¹
- Title III, Part A (English Language Acquisition) - \$19.3 million¹
- Title IV, Part A (Student Support and Academic Enrichment) - \$37.2 million¹
- Title IV, Part B (21st Century Community Learning Centers) - \$35.7 million¹

The USED stated that no Grant Award Notifications (GANs), which include states' access to funds, would be issued to states for these programs on July 1, 2025, as originally scheduled, until the federal funding review is complete.

Below is data on:

- The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) positions that will be impacted by the withholding of these federal funds.
- The amount of federal funding that is being withheld from public school units (PSUs)² and 21st Century Community Learning Center grant recipients.

Impacted Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Positions

North Carolina's 115 traditional school districts (also known as local education agencies, or LEAs) have used the federal grant funding at issue to hire staff for at least 922 full-time equivalent (FTE) positions. The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) does not have data on how many FTEs would be impacted in charter schools, but loss of these funds would impact charter schools as well. If this funding is not provided promptly, the North Carolina public school system would lose at least 922 full-time employees in the field and would be unable to provide the services required by federal law. In addition, 59 FTE positions at NCDPI are funded with these federal funds.³

¹ These amounts are estimates based on 2024-25 awards.

² A public school unit or PSU is a North Carolina entity operating public schools, including local education agencies, charter schools, lab schools, regional schools and other state-operated schools, like the residential schools for the deaf and blind.

³ NCDPI receives just over \$11 million from these federal funding sources for administrative costs and to provide technical assistance.

In addition to FTE positions at LEAs and NCDPI, funding from the 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant program (Title IV, Part B) also support many community-based organizations that provide afterschool and summer programming for students. For the 2024-25 school year, 99 programs (community-based and PSU-based) across the state received funding through the 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant program. Combined, those programs served 10,762 students during the 2024-25 school year and had 1,371 FTE positions supported with federal grant funding.

Allocation of Federal Funding by PSU and Community-Based Organizations

The attached table includes the allocation of federal funding by grant and by recipient (PSU and community-based organization). These are the planning amounts for the 2025-26 school year, with the exception of Title I, Part C and Title IV, Part B, which are usually not included in planning. For those grants, the amounts listed are the amounts awarded in Fiscal Year 2024-25. Amounts do not include statewide program or administration funds used by NCDPI.
